### ORDINANCE

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO.

**SECTION 1.** Title 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by designating as a Pedestrian Street with the appropriate symbols and indications that segment of the West Taylor Right-of-Way on Map No. 2-G in the area bounded by:

the centerline of South Racine Avenue on the east and the centerline of South Loomis Street on the west,  
as a Pedestrian Street.

**SECTION 2.** Section 17-3-0503-D of Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by deleting the struck through language and inserting the underscored language, as follows:

17-3-0503-D [Pedestrian Streets and Pedestrian Retail Streets.]
