BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Street Cleaning Only at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

- Street Cleaning, Ohio from Ashland to Ogden (North side)- 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Second (2) Thursday of every month. April 1 to November 30.[02013-891]
- Street Cleaning, Ohio from Ashland to Ogden (South side)- 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Second (2) Friday of every month. April 1 to November 30. [02013-900]
- East Pearson Street from North Michigan Avenue to North Lake Shore Drive (south side); Street Cleaning Sign, No Parking, 9:00am to 1:00pm, April 1 through October 31 [2021-3617]
