



WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021 President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan CARP"), which provides direct relief to states and local governments for replacement of lost revenue; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified eligible expenses in the Corporate Fund within the 2021 Annual Appropriation Ordinance toward which ARP revenue replacement funds can be applied; and

WHEREAS, the City will be covering \$782.2 million in eligible 2021 expenses with ARP revenue replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to cancel a portion of planned debt restructuring and provide for the repayment of the line of credit used for 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City has also identified Corporate Fund revenues above what were anticipated with the 2021 Annual Appropriation Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2021, the City Council approved a new contract with the Fraternal Order of Police, increasing 2021 expenses by \$274.3 million for current and past salaries; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to issue \$1.2 billion in refinancing to generate \$232 million in savings for Fiscal Year 202 1 to cover a share of these additional contractual expenses; and

WHEREAS, the details of these amendments are set forth in detail on Exhibit A hereto; and

WHEREAS, as part of the above-described federal relief, the City, through several of its offices and departments, has been awarded federal grant funds in the amount of \$1,886,592,000 by the United States Department of the Treasury for the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery program, as set forth in detail on Exhibit B hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City has also been awarded \$71,171,000 by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for the HOME Investment Partnership Program, as set forth in detail on Exhibit B hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City has also been awarded \$360,022,000 by the United States Department of Transportation for the Airport Assistance - ARP Program, as set forth in detail on Exhibit B hereto; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and advisable to amend the 2021 Annual Appropriation Ordinance to effectuate the above-described fiscal improvements and grant awards, now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are adopted and incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The 2021 Annual Appropriation Ordinance is hereby amended by striking the words and figures indicated and by inserting the words and figures indicated on Exhibits A and B attached hereto.

SECTION 3. The Budget Director and heads of the applicable City departments shall administer and use grant funds received pursuant to ARP only as authorized pursuant to the pertinent grant terms, including execution of agreements for eligible projects. The Budget Director shall administer such grant funds directly or through City department designees, including necessary allocation of such funds to, and adjustment as necessary between, said designees.

SECTION 4. To the extent that any ordinance, resolution, rule, order or provision of the Municipal Code of

Chicago, or part thereof, is in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance shall control. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.


