ORDINANCE HUGO'S FROG BAR Acct. No.: 12619-1

Permit No: BACP1604850

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to HUGO'S FROG BAR upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, forty-one (41) Light Fixture(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1024 N RUSH ST.

Said Light Fixture(s) at N. RUSH measure(s):

Twelve (12) at one (1) feet in length, Zero (0) feet in width and twelve point eight (12.8) feet above grade level.

Six (6) at one point four (1.4) feet in length, Zero (0) feet in width and seven point six (7.6) feet above grade level.

Four (4) at six (6) feet in length, Zero (0) feet in width and eight point one (8.1) feet above grade level. Four (4) at one point six (1.6) feet in length, Zero (0) feet in width and eight point eight (8.8) feet above grade level.

Ten (10) at zero point six (0.6) feet in length, Zero (0) feet in width and seven point eight (7.8) feet above grade level.

Three (3) at zero point eight (0.8) feet in length, Zero (0) feet in width and sixteen (16) feet above grade level. Two (2) at zero point six (0.6) feet in length, Zero (0) feet in width and thirteen point five (13.5) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #BACP1604850 herein granted the sum of six hundred ninety-five (\$695.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with

damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 11/01/2021.
