ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 4-60-022.of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language struck through; as follows:

4-60-022 Restrictions on additional licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional license-shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, f or consumption on the premises within the following areas:

SECTION 2. Section 4r60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language struck through, as follows;

4-60-023 Restrictions oh additional licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (cj), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:
