**SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Industrial Permit Parking Zones at the below listed locations:**

#### WARD INDUSTRIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONES:

- 14 4331-4345 West 45th Street (south side) from South Kolin Avenue to the first loading dock west thereof; Industrial Permit Parking Zone 74, All Times, All Days [Or2021-266],
- 14 4237 West 42nd Place (south side) to the first fire hydrant east thereof; Industrial Permit Parking Zone 75, All Times, All Days [Or2022-2]
