WHEREAS, father Dan was born in Norwood Park, Illinois then moved to Park Ridge, Illinois where he attended Main South High School. He graduated from Northern Illinois in DeKalb with a Degree in Business; and

WHEREAS, Father Dan should be recognized and honored for his heroic actions that he took on February 17, 2022 by assisting a person in a.rollover accident; now, therefore


