### **ORDINANCE**

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by changing all the RS3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 12-F in the area bounded by

A line 353.31 feet south of the intersection of West 54<sup>th</sup> Street as measured along the west right-of-way line of South Dearborn Street and perpendicular thereto; South Dearborn Street; a line 378.31 feet south of the intersection of West 54<sup>th</sup> Street as measured along the West right-of-way line of South Dearborn Street and perpendicular thereto; and the alley next west of and Parallel to South Dearborn Street,

to those of a RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.


