1	West Lyndale Street from North Rockwell Street to North Western Avenue; Speed Limitations 20-Miles Per Hour [02022-758]
1	North Rockwell Street from North Milwaukee Avenue to West Fullerton Avenue; Speed Limitations 20-Miles Per Hour [02022-761]
46	North Kenmore Avenue from West Leland Avenue to West Ainslie Street; Speed Limitation-20 Miles Per Hour [02022-721]
46	North Winthrop Avenue from West Leland Avenue to West Ainslie Street; Speed Limitations 20-Miles Per Hour [02022-722]
