BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is

hereby amended by changing all of the Residential/Commercial Planned Development 1006

District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 3-F in the area bounded by

to those of a DR-3 Downtown Residential District.

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

In accordance with the requirements for an Amendment to the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, specifically Section 17-13-0107, please be informed that on or about July 20, 2022, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from Residential/Commercial Planned Development 1006 to DR-3 Downtown Residential District, on behalf of Parkside Associates, LLC, an Illinois limited liability company for the property located at 501-521 West Elm Street; 500-520 West Hobbie Street; 501-521 West Hobbie Street; 500-520 West Oak Street; 1001-1135 North Cambridge Avenue; 1000-1134 North Cleveland Avenue and described as follows:

West Elm Street; North Cleveland Avenue; West Oak Street; North Cambridge Avenue.

PD 1006 is an existing planned development located on 8 contiguous blocks. The purpose of the amendment is to remove two of the blocks from the planned development. The remaining blocks in PD 1006 are developed, except from a portion of Blocks 1 and 7. The undeveloped portions of Blocks 1 and 7 will be designated as new subareas for future residential development.


