TRAFFIC LANE - TOW ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Traffic Lane - Tow Zones, between the limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:

WARD	TOW ZONES:
3	East Cermak Road (north and south sides) from East Michigan Avenue to East Wabash Avenue; No Parking Tow Zone 10:00pm to 6:00am, Thursday to Sunday {02022-1981}
6	East 85th Street (south side) from 347 East 85th Street to 393 East 85th Street; No Parking Tow Zone Sign, 9:30pm to 4:00am, April through December (Revision) {02022-588}
9	West 127th Street (south side) from South State Street To South Wentworth Avenue; No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days 22-04901296 [02022-197]
27	1509 West Fulton Street, No Parking Loading Tow Zone; 5:00am to 5:00pm, Monday-Saturday [02022-1988]
28	North Kostner Avenue (west side) from Kinize Street to West Lake Street; No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days [02022-1591]
