## RESOLUTION EXTENDING CONGRATULATIONS TO KRZYSZTOF SENDECKI FOR ACHIEVING THE RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT

WHEREAS, Krzysztof Sendecki, a member of the Boy Scouts of America Scout Troop 671 and then Troop 810, will be awarded Scouting's highest honor, the rank of Eagle Scout; and

WHEREAS, The City Council has been informed of this special occasion by the Honorable Marty Quinn, Alderman ofthe 13<sup>th</sup> Ward; and

WHEREAS, Krzysztof earned the rank of Eagle Scout on March 27, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Krzysztof's Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project was the PAWS of Chicago, Illinois Collection. Krzysztof was inspired to collect 500 pounds of wet and dry food, leashes, harnesses, blankets, towels, treats, collars, and transfer crates for cats and dogs; as well as office supplies for the organization. The vast number of supplies collected delighted PAWS. He secured drop-off locations at the Stickney Fire Department and Charles J. Sahs Elementary School. Krzysztof was also responsible for cleaning and organizing the Chicago PAWS site where donated items would be kept for future use. Krzysztof completed 62 hours towards his Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project; and

WHEREAS, Attaining the rank of Eagle Scout is achieved by only two percent of young men who enroll in the scouting program. To become an Eagle Scout, a Scout must earn twenty-one merit badges in addition to. completing several community service projects; and

WHEREAS, Krzysztof Sendecki has completed all ofthe requirements for the rank of Eagle Scout and has been examined by an Eagle Scout Board of Review, certifying his worthiness for Scouting's highest distinction and now joins the ranks of many successful and influential Eagle Scouts; now, therefore,
