BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend 2% Disabled Parking at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

50 Amend Ordnance Which Reads:6710 North Washtenaw Avenue (west side)

> from a point 175 feet south of West Pratt Avenue to a point 20 feet south thereof, 2% Disabled Parking, 7:00am-4:30pm, Monday-Friday, by striking the above and inserting North Fairfield Avenue (east side) from a point 90 feet north of West North Shore Avenue to a point 20 feet north thereof, 2% Disabled Permit, 7:00am-4:40pm, Monday-Friday [02022-3355]

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage
