WHEREAS, He was appointed a member of the Pontifical Biblical Commission by Pope Saint John Paul II in 2001, and reappointed for a second term by Pope Benedict XVI in 2006; and

WHEREAS, He was a frequent lecturer and speaker throughout the United States and abroad and was actively involved in interreligious dialogue, particularly with the Jewish and Muslim communities; and

WHEREAS, He was the recipient of the National Catholic Library Association's 1994 Jerome Award for Outstanding Scholarship and the 1996 National Catholic Education Association's Bishop Loras Lane Award for outstanding service to Catholic education; and

WHEREAS, In 2013, he received the O'Connell-Douglas Award for his contribution to inter-religious and ecumenical harmony, and the Gutenberg Award for biblical scholarship; and

WHEREAS, In 2014, he was granted by the Governor of Illinois the Order of Lincoln Award, the state's highest honor for public service; and

WHEREAS, To his beloved family, Father Senior imparts a legacy of generosity, compassion, devotion to family and unwavering faith in God; now, therefore
