2 1700-1780 North Marcey Street (west side) from West Willow Street to West

Wisconsin Street; Parking Meters[O2023-1131]

27 201-299 North Sangamon Street, Paybox #756313 on North Sangamon Street

(eastside only) from West Lake Street to West Fulton Market by temporarily relocating parking meters Pay box # 756313 to West Wayman Street (northside) from North Halsted Street to North

Peoria Street; Amend Parking Meters, April 4, 2023-April 4, 2024 [02023-1189]
