WHEREAS, The management of its finances is a matter pertaining to the government and affairs of the City of Chicago; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1: The City Comptroller and the City Treasurer are authorized and directed to make the following transfer of funds for the year 2011.
