### AUTHORIZATION FOR ISSUANCE OF FREE PERMITS FOR CERTAIN CHARITABLE, EDUCATIONAL AND RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS.

#### *Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Buildings, the Executive Director of Construction and Permits, the Commissioner of Transportation, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, the Commissioner of Environment, the Commissioner of Fire, the Director of Revenue and the Commissioner of the Department of Water Management are hereby authorized and directed to issue all necessary permits, free of charge, notwithstanding other ordinances of the City of Chicago to the contrary, to Irving Park Lutheran Church, a not-for-profit religious institution, related to the erection, maintenance, and renovation of building(s), property, and parking areas located at 4103 N. Pulaski, 4111-13 N. Pulaski, 3938 W. Belle Plaine, 4108 N. Harding, 4112 N. Harding, and 4057 N. Harding.

Said building(s) and all appurtenances thereto shall be used exclusively for religious, educational, and related purposes and shall not be leased or otherwise used with a view to profit, and the work thereon shall be done in accordance with plans submitted and all of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago and departmental requirements of various departments of the City of Chicago. Said building(s) and all appurtenances thereto shall be constructed and maintained so that they shall comply in all respects to the requirements of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago for the issuance of all permits and licenses.

SECTION 2. Irving Park Lutheran Church, a not-for-profit religious institution, shall be exempt from the payment of city license fees and shall be entitled to the cancellation of warrants for the collection of inspection fees.

SECTION 3. Irving Park Lutheran Church shall be entitled to a refund of City fees which it has paid and to which it is exempt pursuant to Section 1 of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
