ORDINANCE 7-ELEVEN Acct. No. 65465 - 36 Permit No. 1108468

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 7-ELEVEN, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, three (3) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1524 W. Taylor St..

Said Awning(s) at W. TAYLOR ST. measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-two (22) feet in length, and three point six seven (3.67) feet in width for a total of eighty point seven four (80.74) square feet.

Said Awning(s) at W. TAYLOR ST. measure(s):

One (1) at nine point zero eight (9.08) feet in length, and three point six seven (3.67) feet in width for a total of thirty-three point three two (33.32) square feet.

Said Awning(s) at W. TAYLOR ST. measure(s): One (1) at forty-one point eight three (41.83) feet in length, and three point six seven (3.67) feet in width for a total of one hundred fifty-three point five two (153.52) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1108468 herein granted the sum of one hundred sixty-six dollars and eighty-three cents (\$166.83) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date. Page 1
