Ms. Dennis's last employment was as the Property Manager for Bethel Terrace, a 123 unit housing complex for seniors and disabled persons in the Englewood neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, Laura Dennis, a loving mother of three, devoted grandmother of seven and a great grandmother of two will now have more quality time to spend with her family; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable JoAnn Thompson, Alderman of the 16th Ward has apprised this august body of the significant milestone of Laura Dennis; now, therefore
