11	4401 S. Normal Avenue, Disabled Permit 91015. NOT RECOMMENDED, no corner clearance [02013-8501]
13	6401 S. Narragansett Avenue, Disabled Permit 89655. NOT RECOMMENDED, garage at location [02013-9127]

#### WARD AMEND LOADING ZONES:

48 800 block of W. Carmen Avenue; Amend 15 Minute Standing Zone / Tow Zone. NOT RECOMMENDED, information needed to prepare recommendation for this ordinance is not available - (12-01960992) [02012-6060]

#### WARD RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONES:

19 3900-3927 W. 104th Street, Residential Permit Parking Zone. NOT RECOMMENDED, there is a requirement that at least 85% on the street parking, it was only 35% [O2013-5584]

#### WARD TOW AWAY:

W. Carmen Avenue from N. Marine Drive going west to the parking garage entrance, No Parking Tow Zone. NOT RECOMMENDED, information needed to prepare recommendation for this ordinance is not available - (12-01948242) [02012-6127]
