RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 090, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, portions of the below named streets are hereby designated as residential permit parking zones, for the following locations:

Carmen Avenue to W. Foster Avenue, Residential Permit Parking Zone 37, and inserting in lieu thereof: N. Springfield Avenue (east side) from W. Carmen Avenue to W. Foster Avenue, Residential Permit Parking Zone 37, all times [02014-270]
