MISCELLANEOUS SIGNS

CONSULATE PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to remove Consulate Parking signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

230 E. Ohio Street; Repeal ordinance passed 3/13/13, journal page 48790, which reads: E. Ohio Street (north side) from a point 204 feet east of N. St. Clair Street to a point 20 feet east thereof; Palau Consulate Parking Only, by striking the above -- (14-01000875) [02014-4737]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication. CHICAGO, JULY 30, 2014
