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### **ORDINANCE**

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by changing all the B3-5 Community Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 7-J in the area bounded by:

North Spaulding Avenue; the public alley next northeast of North Milwaukee Avenue; North Sawyer Avenue; and North Milwaukee Avenue

to those of a Cl-5 Neighborhood Commercial District which is hereby established in the area described above.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

The undersigned, Rolando R. Acosta, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and says the following:

That the undersigned certifies that he has complied with the requirements of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, Title 17, Section 13-0107-A of the Municipal Code of Chicago, by serving written notice by USPS first class mail, to the owners of all property within 250 feet in each direction of the lot lines of the subject property, the boundaries of which are:

Please take notice that under the Chicago Zoning Ordinance an application (the "Application") to change the B3-5 Community Shopping District to those of a Cl-5 Neighborhood Commercial District for the area which is bounded by:

North Spaulding Avenue; the public alley next northeast of North Milwaukee Avenue; North Sawyer Avenue; and North Milwaukee Avenue

(hereafter the "Property") will be filed on or about March 10, 2015 with the Department of Planning and Development, City of Chicago by Cold One, Inc., 2725 N.
