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ORDINANCE SAMUEL M.  
MENCOFF Acct. No. 398098 - 1  
Permit No 1118600

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to SAMUEL M. MENCOFF, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, Occupation of Space for a wrought iron fence on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1250 N. Lake Shore Dr..

Said Occupation of Space (Fence) at N. Lake Shore Drive measure(s):

One (1) at seventy-nine (79) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of seventy-nine (79) square feet. Existing wrought fence is approximately six (6) feet in height.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development, Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development), and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1118600 herein granted the sum of one thousand seven hundred sixty-two (\$1,762.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 03/10/2019\
