TRAFFIC LANE - TOW ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Traffic Lane - Tow Zones, between the limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:

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42 TOW ZONES:

1325 West 15th Street; West 15th Street (north side) from a point 35 feet west of South Throop Street to a point 85 feet west thereof; No Parking Tow Zone, 6:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday, Private Benefit - (15-00278006) [02015-773]

North Oleander Avenue; North Oleander Avenue (west side) from a point 85 feet south of West Irving Park Road to a point 35 feet south thereof; No Parking Tow Zone, 7:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Friday, Public Benefit - (16-01013164) [02016-526]

5000 North Central Park Avenue; North Central Park Avenue (east and west sides) between West Argyle Street and West Carmen Avenue; No Parking Tow Zone, 7:00am to 9:00am (west side) and 4:00pm to 6:00pm (east side), Monday through Friday [02016-2568]

79-99 West Huron Street; West Huron Street (south side) from North Clark Street to a point 75 feet east thereof; No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days, Public Benefit -(15-06651897) [02015-8405]

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WARD AMEND TOW ZONES:

50 East Huron Street; Repeal Ordinance which reads: East Huron Street from a point
124 feet east of North Wabash Avenue to a point 24 feet east thereof; No Parking Tow Zone, by Striking the above - (15-03616039) [02015-4009]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
