RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 090, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, portions of the below named streets are hereby designated as Residential Permit Parking Zones, for the following locations:

1051-1101 East 80th Street; 1051-1101 East 80th Street (south side) from the alley east of South Dobson Avenue to South Greenwood Avenue; Residential Parking Permit Zone 353, All Times, All Days [Or2016-282]

8800-8899 South Yates Boulevard; 8800 South Yates Boulevard (west side); Residential Permit Parking Zone 501, 7:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday [Or2016-367]

1500-1599 South Karlov Avenue; South Karlov Avenue (east and west sides); Residential Permit Parking Zone 1942, All Times, All Days [Or2016-348]

West 34th Street; Residential Permit Parking Zone 361 to include West 34th Street from South Claremont Avenue to South Western Avenue [Or2016-354]

5057-5099 West Jackson Boulevard; 5057-5099 West Jackson Boulevard (south side); Residential Permit Parking Zone 1943, All Times, All Days [Or2016-287]

5300-5399 West Oakdale Avenue; 5300-5399 West Oakdale Avenue (north and south sides); Residential Permit Parking Zone 1498, 6:00pm to 6:00am, All Days [Or2016-377]

5200-5299 West Schubert Avenue; 5200-5299 West Schubert Avenue (north and south sides); Residential Permit Parking Zone 1033, 6:00pm to 6:00am, All Days [Or2016-378]

2600-2650 North Kildare Avenue; 2600-2650 North Kildare Avenue (west side); Residential Permit Parking Zone 802, 6:00pm to 6:00am, All Days [Or2016-379]

30	North Monticello Avenue; Amend Ordinance Passed 09/24/2015, journal page 7023, which reads: North Monticello Avenue (east and west sides); Residential Permit Parking Zone 1871, from West Roscoe Street and West Cornelia Avenue, to include West Roscoe Street (north side) from North Monticello Avenue to first alley east thereof [02016-2618]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
