Committee on License and Consumer Protection City Council Meeting, September 14, 2016 Alderman Brendan Reilly, 42nd Ward Liquor Moratorium

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the area described in Section 2 of this ordinance is adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the area.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-023 (42.5), as follows:

4-60-023 Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

(42.5) On the North side of Ontario Street from N Fairbanks Ct to N St Clair Street. (Omitted text is

unaffected by this ordinance)

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon passage and publication.
