ORDINANCE
UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO Acct. No.
43697 - 39 Permit No. 1124733

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, three (3) Pipe(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5646-570146 S. Drexel Ave..

Said Pipe(s) at 5646 S. 5701 S. ALLEY EAST OF S. DREXEL AVE- S. DREXEL AVE 912-E. 919 E. 57TH ST measure (s):

One (1) at two hundred ten (210) feet in length, and one point five (1.5) foot in width for a total of three hundred fifteen (315) square feet. Existing pipe is approximately three (3) feet in depth.

One (1) at two hundred ten (210) feet in length, and point eight three (.83) feet in width for a total of one hundred seventy four point three (174.3) square feet. Existing pipe is approximately three (3) feet below grade level.

One (1) at two hundred ten (210) feet in length, and point two five (.25) feet in width for a total of fifty-two point five (52.5) square feet. Existing pipe is approximately three (3) feet below grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination) and Department of Water Management.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1124733 herein granted the sum of one thousand two hundred (\$1,200.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.
