ORDINANCE 854 WEST RANDOLPH LLC Acct. No. 407180-1 Permit No. 1124981

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 854 WEST RANDOLPH LLC, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use eighteen (18) Exterior mount(s) (Heat Strips) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 846-854 W. Randolph St..

Said Exterior mount(s) (Heat Strips) at W. Randolph measure(s):

Thirteen (13) at five (5) feet in length, and point three four (.34) feet in width for a total of twenty-two point one (22.1) square feet. Heat strips shall be approximately twelve (12) feet above grade level. Said heat strips shall be underneath canopies at certain sections and intervals.

Said Exterior mount(s) at N. Peoria measure(s):

Five (5) at five (5) feet in length, and point three four (.34) feet in width for a total of eight point five (8.5) square feet. Heat strips shall be approximately twelve (12) feet above grade level. Said heat strips shall be underneath canopies at certain sections and intervals.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1124981 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
