Committee on License and Consumer Protection City Council Meeting, March 29, 2017 Alderman Brendan Reilly, 42^{n<1} Ward Liquor Moratorium,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds, that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely -affected by the over-concentration'of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within-and near the areas.

SECTION 2, Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, is hereby.amended¹ by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-022 (42.42), as follows:

4-60-022 Restrictions on additional licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor; for consumption on the premises' within the following areas:

On the south side only of Erie Streetfrom Orleans'Street to Wells Street.
