#### SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as new subsections 4-60-023 (49.68 through 49.70), as follows:

#### 4-60-023 Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.


Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

(49.68)	$\underline{\text{On the north side only of Devon Avenue, from Greenview Avenue to Glenwood}} \\ \underline{\text{Avenue.}}$
(49.69)	$\frac{\text{On the north side only of Devon Avenue, from Glenwood Avenue to Lakewood}}{\text{Avenue.}}$
(49.70)	On the north side only of Devon Avenue, from Lakewood Avenue to Sheridan Road.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
