ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICA GO:

SECTION 1. Title 17, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by changing all the RS3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No.7-1 in the area bounded by

a line 205.42 feet south of and parallel West Logan Boulevard;. North Fairfield Avenue; a line 230.42 feet south of and parallel West Logan Boulevard; and the alley next west of and parallel North Fairfield Avenue,

to those of a RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District and a .r corresponding use district is hereby established in the area above described.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in/force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.
