TRAFFIC WARNING SIGN AND/OR SIGNALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

- WARD TRAFFIC WARNING SIGNS AND/OR SIGNALS:
- 2 West Rice Street and North Hoyne Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches -- (16-08221021) [Or2016-627]
- 2 West Walton Street and North Hoyne Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches -- (16-08220875) [Or2016-628]
- 8 South Greenwood Avenue and East 89th Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches -- (17-00710251) [Or2017-29]
- 9 South Indiana Avenue and East 92nd Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches (16-04934989) [Or2016-346]
- 10 South Avenue G and East 115th Street; Stop Sign, Stopping Southbound Avenue G for Eastbound 115th Street [02017-6062]
- 15 South Hoyne Avenue and West 50th Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches - (17-02784122) [Or2017-211]
- 15 South Oakley Avenue and West 48th Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches -- (17-02752612) [Or2017-212]
- 15 South Oakley Avenue and West 47th Place; Stop Sign, Stopping South Oakley at West 47th Place (17-02752361) [Or2017-213]
- 26 West Hirsch Street and North Maplewood Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping all Approaches -- (17-04639005) [02017-3954]
- 28 West Jackson Boulevard and South Kilbourn Avenue; All Way Stop Sign. Not Recommended. West Jackson Boulevard is a collector roadway with Significantly higher traffic volumes than South Kilbourn Avenue. Due to the intersections proximity to the traffic signal at West Jackson Boulevard and South Kostner Avenue, a stop sign would be unexpected for motorists and can lead to increased safety concerns. CDOT does not recommend and all-way stop sign at this location because it can increase rear-end crashes, increase congestion, and create a false sense of security for pedestrians that every vehicle will stop. CDOT does not recommend installing an All way stop at this intersection.
