SECTION 1: Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is amended by changing all the B3-3 Community Shopping District and RM5 Residential Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 3-F in the area bounded by:

West Schiller Street;

a line 110.2 feet east of and parallel to North Sedgwick Street; a line 116 feet south of and parallel to West Schiller Street; a line 134.6 feet east of and parallel to North Sedgwick Street; a line 141 feet south of and parallel to West Schiller Street; the public alley next east of and parallel to North Sedgwick Street; a line 166 feet south of and parallel to West Schiller Street; and North Sedgwick Street;

to those of B3-5 Community Shopping District, which is hereby established in the area above described.

SECTION 2: Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is amended by changing all the B3-5 Community Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 3-F in the area bounded by:

West Schiller Street;

- 7. For purposes of height measurement, the definitions in the Chicago Zoning Ordinance shall apply. The height of any building shall also be subject to height limitations, if any, established by the Federal Aviation Administration.
- 8. The maximum permitted floor area ratio (FAR) for the Property shall be in accordance with the attached Bulk Regulations and Data Table. For the purpose of FAR calculations and measurements, the definitions in the Zoning Ordinance shall apply. The Applicant acknowledges that it is in the public interest to design, construct, renovate and maintain all buildings in a manner that provides healthier indoor environments, reduces operating costs and conserves energy and natural resources. The Applicant shall obtain the number of points necessary to meet the requirements of the Chicago Sustainable Development Policy, in effect at the time the Part II review process is initiated for each improvement that is subject to the aforementioned Policy and must provide documentation verifying compliance.
- 15. The Applicant acknowledges the city's ongoing and evolving initiatives to enhance awareness of, and support and encourage participation by, Minority and Women's Business Enterprise certified contractors and local city residents. If the developer elects to provide affordable units off-site, the off-site affordable units must be located within a two-mile

radius from the residential housing project and in the same or a different higher income area or downtown district. The Property is located in a higher income area, within the meaning of the ARO, and the project has a total of 98 units. As a result, the Applicant's affordable housing obligation is 10 affordable units (10% of 98), 2 of which are Required Units (25% of 10, rounded down). Applicant has agreed to satisfy its affordable housing obligation by making a cash payment to the Affordable Housing Opportunity Fund in the amount of \$125,000 (\$100,000, if providing units on-site to CHA) per unit (Cash Payment) and/or providing 2 affordable units in the rental/for sale building to be constructed in the PD and/or 8 affordable units in an off-site building located at TBD and/or entering into an agreement with the Chicago Housing Authority (CHA) to provide affordable units in the PD, as set forth in the Affordable Housing Profile Form attached hereto as Exhibit A. The Applicant agrees that the affordable rental/for sale units must be affordable to households earning no more than 100% of the Chicago Primary Metropolitan Statistical Area Median Income (AMI), as updated annually by the City of Chicago. If the Applicant subsequently reduces (or increases) the number of housing units in the PD, the Applicant shall update and resubmit the Affordable Housing Profile Form to DPD for review and approval; DPD may adjust the number of required Affordable Units without amending the PD. Prior to the issuance of any building permits for any residential building in the PD, including, without limitation, excavation or foundation permits, the Applicant must make the required Cash Payment and/or execute and record an affordable

housing agreement in accordance with Section 2-45-115(L). The terms of the affordable housing agreement and any amendments thereto are incorporated herein by this reference. The Applicant acknowledges and agrees that the affordable housing agreement will be recorded against the PD, or the applicable portion thereof, and will constitute a lien against such property. The Commissioner of DPD may enforce remedies for any breach of this Statement 16, including any breach of any affordable housing agreement, and enter into settlement agreements with respect to any such breach, subject to the approval of the Corporation Counsel, without amending the PD.

17. This Planned Development shall be governed by Section 17-13-0612. Should this Planned Development ordinance lapse, the Commissioner of the Department of Planning and Development shall initiate a Zoning Map Amendment to rezone the property to the pre-existing B3-5 Community Shopping District.
