TRAFFIC LANE - TOW ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Traffic Lane - Tow Zones, between the limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:

27	3151 West Walnut Street; No Parking Tow Zone except for Official School Personnel Permit Parking Only, 7:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday [02018-3096]
42	North Wabash Avenue (west side) from East Superior Street to a point 62 feet north thereof; No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days - (17-04764152) [02017-4921]
42	East Ohio Street (north and south sides) from North Fairbanks Court to North Lake Shore Drive; No Parking Tow Zone, 11:00pm to 6:00am -- (17-05100946) [02017-5568]
42	North LaSalle Street (east side) from West Lake Street to a point 110 feet north thereof; No Parking Tow Zone - (17-07156219) [02017-7596]
44	North Halsted Street (west side) from West Cornelia Avenue to West Addison Street; No Standing, No Parking, Tow Zone, 12:00am to 4:00am, Saturday, Sunday and Monday, April 1st to September 30th, Public Benefit -- (18-00914317) [02018-1313]
