WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, Mark A. Braun was a widely admired member of the legal community who specialized in workers compensation law cases; and

WHEREAS, Mark A. Braun was the much-adored father of Beth, Jane and Eric to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities that he possessed in abundance; and

WHEREAS, Mark A. Braun was the dear brother of Robert and Sister Jeanne Marie; and

WHEREAS, Mark A. Braun retired from practice in 2016 at the age of 91 after 68 years of dedication to the highest ideals of his profession; and

WHEREAS, The hard work and commitment of Mark A. Braun serve as an example to all; now, therefore
