#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:


SECTION 1. Section 2-8-110 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

2-8-110 Term of office.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

Any person elected to the City Council of the City of Chicago shall serve no more than two four-year terms in office.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
