ORDINANCE RUSH UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER Acct. No. 62954 - 31 Permit No. 1139083

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to RUSH UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use three (3) Earth Retention System(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1520 W. Harrison St..

Said Earth Retention System(s) at 527 S Ashland Ave measure(s): One (1) at ten point four four (10.44) feet in length, and two (2) feet in width for a total of twenty point eight (20.88) square feet.

Said Earth Retention System(s) at 1554 W Harrison St measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-six point three (26.3) feet in length, and two (2) feet in width for a total of fifty-two point six (52.6) square feet.

Said Earth Retention System(s) at 523 S Ashland Ave measure(s): One (1) at point four eight (.48) feet in length, and two (2) feet in width for a total of point nine six (.96) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1139083 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
