BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

Section 1:

The ordinance passed by the City Council of the City of Chicago for BRODER DIVERSEY LLC on 12/14/2016, and printed upon page 40104 of the Journal of Proceedings of the City of Chicago is here by Amended by deleting the words "One (1) at twelve (12) feet in length, and two (2) feet in width for a total of twenty-four (24) square feet.; seventy-five (\$75.00) per annum" and inserting in their place the words "Three (3) at twelve (12) feet in length, and seventy-four (74) feet in width for a total of two thousand six hundred sixty-four (2,664) square feet; two hundred twenty-five (\$225.00) per annum"
