BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS-3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 13-J in the area bounded by

A Line 208.97 feet north of and Parallel to West Ainslie Street; North Drake Avenue; A Line 178.97 feet North of and Parallel to West Ainslie Street; and the alley next West of and Parallel to North Drake Avenue

To those of RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.


