ORDINANCE METRO BY T-MOBILE Acct. No. 460063 - 1 Permit No. 1146182

Be It Ordained by the City Council ofthe City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to METRO BY T-MOBILE, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use one (1) sign(s) projecting over the public.right-of-way attached-to'its premises known as 5603 W. BelmontAve..

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along W. BelmontAvenue:

One.(1) at twelve pointfive eight (12.58) feet in length, one point six seven (1.67) feet in height and ten (10) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk. •

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division: of Project Development); and Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public-way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as.compensation for the,privilege #1146182 herein granted the sum of one hundred (\$100.00) per annum in advance. ...'

A 25% penalty will, be added for payments; received-after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
