ORDINANCE NORTHWESTERN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL Acct. No. 85392 -7 Permit No. 1147304

Se It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to NORTHWESTERN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, five (5) Planter(s) on the public right-of-way for beautification purposes adjacent to its premises known as 710 N. Fairbanks Ct..

Said Planter(s) at East huron measure(s):

One (1) at seventy-eight point nine (78.9) feet in length, and seven point six (7.6) feet in width for a total of five hundred ninety-nine point six four (599.64) square feet.

Said Planter(s) at E. Huron measure(s):

One (1) at fifty-two point six (52.6) feet in length, and seven point six (7.6) feet in width for a total of three hundred ninety-nine point seven six (399.76) square feet.

Said Planter(s) at E. Superior measure(s):

One (1) at forty-one point three (41.3) feet in length, and seven point six (7.6) feet in width for a total of three hundred thirteen point eight (313.88) square feet.

Said Planter(s) at E. Superior measure(s):

One (1) at forty-one point three (41.3) feet in length, and seven point six (7.6) feet in width for a total of three hundred thirteen point eight (313.88) square feet.

Said Planter(s) at E. Superior measure(s):

Grantee must allow the required clear and unobstructed space for pedestrian passage at all times per rules and regulations approved by the Department of Transportation.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1147304 herein granted the sum of zero (\$.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 11/15/2020.
