TRAFFIC WARNING SIGN AND/OR SIGNALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

- 7 South South Shore and East 74th Street All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [02021-1677] South Oglesby Avenue and East 74th Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping 7 All Approaches [02021-1678] 7 South Merrill Avenue and East 74th Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [02021-1679] South Crandon Avenue and East 74th Street; All Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches 7 [02021-1823] Recommended To Read South Kilbourn Avenue and W 64th Place All-Way Stop, 13 Stopping All Approaches [Or2021-52] 21-03869434 27 700 North Ada Street All Way Stop Sign located at North Ada Street and West Huron Street [02021-1676] 39 "West Bryn Mawr Avenue (north and south) From a point 750' East Of North Pulaski Road To North Spaulding Avenue No Parking Of Semis Tow Zone [02020-6160] -21-03609580" 39 West Rosemont Avenue and North Knox Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches.
