BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Loading Zones for the distances specified, during the hours specified:

WARD LOADING ZONES / STANDING ZONES:

- 1 2355 West Augusta Boulevard, Amend Ordinance by increasing footage 40 feet west, Amend Loading Zone, 7:00am-12:00am, All Days [02021-1609]
- 24 3159 West Fillmore Street (Southside) 30 Minute Standing Zone; from a point 20 feet East of South Homan Avenue to a point 65 feet east thereof, All Days, All Times [02021-1881]
- -47 "Recommended To Read; North Lincoln Avenue (east side),rrom A Point 20' North Of
 West I lutchinson Otreet, To A Point 20' North Thoroof, 15 Minuto Standing Zono, Uoo-Flaohing Lighto 0:00AM to 5:00 PM Mondoy Thru Friday Tow Zone (Public) [O2021-2195] 21-03901289"

50 North Whipple Street Westside from a point 30 feet North of West Peterson Avenue to a point 25 feet North thereof; 15 Minute Standing Zone, use Flashing Lights, 6:00AM to 7:00PM Monday through Friday by Striking to a point 30 feet North thereof and Inserting in lieu thereof to a point 55 feet North thereof, [02021-2195]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
