WHEREAS, The Members of this Chamber were deeply saddened to learn of the death on December 20, 2010, at age 68, of Patricia Green, a distinguished Chicagoan and dedicated public servant; and

WHEREAS, Although Mrs. Green will be dearly missed, the impact of her kindness and many good deeds will continue to inspire others, and her memory will live on in the hearts of those who were privileged to know her; and
WHEREAS, A truly exemplary human being, Mrs. Green will always be remembered for her selfless dedication to public service, her many contributions to the City of Chicago, and for her decency, strength of character, and faith; and
WHEREAS, Mrs. Green is survived by her husband of forty-nine years, G. Patrick Green; her daughter, Susan; her grandchildren, Michael and Timothy Pistillon; her brothers-and sisters-in-law, Charles and Margaret Green, Bill and Dorothy Green, Richard and Charlene Green, and Thomas Green, and a host of other family members and friends; now, therefore,
BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and Members of the City Council of the City of Chicago, assembled this thirteenth day of January, 2011, do hereby honor the life and memory of Patricia Green, and extend our heartfelt condolences to her family; and
